UPDATE ON LOCAL ROAD REPAIRS

Thank you to those residents who contacted me about roads and pavements that need resurfacing or replacement.

At the end of last year, we submitted the list of suggestions to the Council's Highways Department. In February and March this year, Highways Inspectors visited each road to decide whether to include each suggestion or to undertake temporary patching.

I am pleased to advise that the Highways Inspectors agreed with our request to include a number of roads in this year's programme for major works.

The full list of roads to be resurfaced this year:

Farmside	Witley Close
Ivy Lane	Blackthorne Close
Lyons Road	Sandbrook Lane
Wilkes Avenue	Croft Drive
Witley Avenue	Stavordale Road

Shortly before works are to begin, the Highways Department will notify you of the date and likely duration, as well as any additional requests you may have – such as 'access protection markings' or removal or introduction of designated disabled parking bays.

We will also update residents through our regular Newsline and on our Facebook page News for Moreton and Leasowe
