**UPDATE ON MOSSLANDS DRIVE ROAD RESURFACING**

You may be aware that, over the last two years, the Council has at first agreed to repair Mosslands Drive, only to then amend the programme for each year with the result that it was removed from the list in both 2018 and 2019.

Last year, many residents signed our petition during our doorstep visit, asking for the road to be resurfaced. Some pot holes were filled but the road remains in a poor state of repair.

Since then, your three local councillors - Lesley, Paul and I - have met with the Council's Assistant Director of Highways.


**I am pleased to advise that, following those discussions, the Assistant Director has agreed with our request to include Mosslands Drive in this year's programme for major works.**

Shortly before works are to begin, the Highways Department will notify you of the date and likely duration, as well as any additional requests residents may have - such as 'access protection markings' or removal or introduction of designated disabled parking bays.
